ASB/Crime/Criminal Damage

In collaboration with Licensing Team, several businesses across the Carfax and West Street have been advised to keep A-Boards close to their premises and leaflets have been handed out.

Person(s) Begging in West Street and Middle Street. These individuals have been asked to stop begging, their details have been passed to Sussex Police and Border Force at Gatwick. NW spoke with person(s) offered support and informed them this was illegal, in which they stopped and signposted to relevant agencies to get the help they need. Working in Partnership with Sussex Police and Immigration Services. CPWs will be issued to persistent offenders. We encourage members of the public to support local charities such as Horsham Matters and Turning Tides.

I have patrolled with several PCSOs from NPT covering town centre providing a uniformed presence along with Street Briefings for members of the public to chat to us.

Operation Sceptre is a national initiative that takes place twice a year. The operation aims to raise awareness of knife crime and the police action in detecting, reducing, and preventing it. The week of action is also an opportunity for people to surrender any knives or any bladed article that could be used as a weapon at one of the forever amnesty bins which are permanently located at Horsham Police Station.

Support Sussex Police with an arrest of an individual on West Street.

Community engagement/events/meetings

Badgers Horsham received a personal safety talk from PCSO Bell and PCSO Norman. We met with the leaders and participants, played games and introduced our role for the community.

Following The Butterfly Project visit to Sussex Police station, I arranged a visit to West Sussex Fire & Rescue Services at Broadbridge Heath. In collaboration with WSFRS & Sussex Police we provided a tour of the site, discussed safety in the home and demonstrations from the Billingshurst Crew.



WSFRS completed an exercise at The Forum, to ensure all dry risers are working correctly.
