ABOUT HUGH WARWICK

Hugh is an ecologist and writer with a particular fondness for hedgehogs. The first of his three books (so far!) about hedgehogs was, *A Prickly Affair*, and this remains unique for having accolades from both Jeanette Winterson and Ann Widdecombe on the cover.

Hugh's second hedgehog book was called <u>Hedgehog</u>, and published in April 2014 by Reaktion Books. It is a monograph on the iconography of the hedgehog - niche, yes, but also full of fun and beautiful illustrations.

Most recently, September 2020, <u>The Hedgehog Book</u>-published by Graffeg. This looks at the hedgehog from both the scientific and the less scientific points of view - illustrated with oodles of gorgeous photographs.

In addition to writing, Hugh does a lot of <u>public speaking</u> (from primary schools to postgraduate research groups via the WI and Wildlife Trusts). He also runs day-long courses on hedgehog conservation and lectures in creative writing.

Hugh is spokesperson for the <u>British Hedgehog Preservation Society</u>.
